

# Tips for In-Home Service Providers



## Before Arriving to the Home:

- Contact customer to ensure there is not an increased risk for COVID-19 exposure. Make sure there is no one in the home who is sick or quarantined for COVID-19 exposure.
- Stay home if you are sick. Do not enter a patron's home while symptomatic.



## While Working in the Home:

- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer often.
- Use disposable shoe covers if available.
- Do not shake hands.
- Keep a distance of at least 6 ft between you and others.
- Use antiseptic wipes to wipe down your equipment, tool bag, and cell phone after each stop.



## Other Considerations:

- The CDC is now recommending wearing cloth face coverings in public settings.
- In-home service providers may say the following to put the customer at ease:
  - I want to let you know that I am healthy and do not have symptoms of COVID-19.
  - I have been following social distancing and personal hygiene guidelines.
